AKA "INVASIVE PLANTS"



RUSSIAN THISTLE AKA TUMBLEWEED

Noxious & Invasive Annual
HIGHLY FLAMMABLE
Flowers June to October
Mostly found along Roadways and Paths
Each Plant can produce up to 250,000 seeds!
Harvest when green
PULL - DISCARD IN TRASH



SCOTCH THISTLE AKA CANADIAN THISTLE

Thorny, Noxious & Invasive
Annual or Biennial
Abundant purplish flowers per plant
Produces thousands of seeds
Found in irrigated areas
Nasty, penetrating thorns on stalk
PULL - DISCARD IN TRASH



COMMON MULLEIN AKA WOOLY MULLEIN

Noxious & Invasive Bi-Annual
First year plants are low growing, greygreen rosettes; second year plants grow 3-6
feet high with a yellow flowering stalk
Blooms June to August
Prolific seeder
PULL - DISCARD IN TRASH



SPOTTED KNAPWEED

Noxious & Invasive Perennial
Grows up to 4 feet with deeply lobed leaves
Flowers are pink or purple
Roots release a chemical that keeps native
plants from growing
Wear Gloves
PULL - DISCARD IN TRASH
