

# READY FOR FIRE SEASON?



## RECOA FIREFREE EVENT APRIL 19 THRU MAY 6

- ▶ Concentrate on preparing your ***Home Ignition Zone (HIZ)*** (30 Feet from the home structure)--see guidelines on the RECOA website under CWP Committee.
- ▶ Pile flammable yard debris on the edge of the road next to your property beginning April 19th, **OR help by delivering 30-gallon heavy duty paper landscaping bags beginning April 28th to dumpster sites at Cinnamon Teal/Merlin or Oxbow Loop near the Equestrian Center.**
- ▶ Flammable debris includes evergreen limbs, sage, rabbit brush, bitter brush, pine needles, dry leaves, and long, dry grasses. Smaller plant debris should be put in heavy duty paper landscape bags.
- ▶ **Cut limbs or small trees into sections no longer than 8 feet.**
- ▶ ***Please, wait until April 19th to put debris out along the street.***
- ▶ ***No root balls, grass clippings, plastic bags, rocks, household trash, sod, potting soil or yucca plants will be picked up!!***
